1 ♦ HUMILITY

◆ A FIRM FOUNDATION

“The Most Excellent Way” began in early 1986 as a small prayer group desiring to minister to alcoholics, drug addicts, and their families within our church. Today, regularly scheduled Support Meetings continue to spread across America, into Mexico, Australia, Poland, Russia, Ukraine, South America, India, Nepal ...

“The Most Excellent Way” Christian solution to chemical dependency is *becoming GOD-dependent*. Our principles of recovery are based entirely upon God’s Word.

DISCIPLE (*Matthew 28:19-20*),
MEND (*Luke 4:18-19*) and
SEND (*Acts 1:8*) people in Jesus’ name.

◆ DISCIPLESHIP

The understanding of the principle and practice of *surrender* are the basic needs for the recovering addict and alcoholic, and family members. *Who* and/or *what* we surrender to is the key to change.

The process of permanently changing the outward compulsive habits and self-centered behavior is accomplished from the *inside out* — it is a matter of the heart. We view “recovery” as the *sanctification* process of new life *in* Christ.

“The Most Excellent Way” is centered upon Jesus’ Sermon on the Mount, specifically the Beatitudes. With Jesus’ Sermon as our foundation, we learn:

- To examine our hearts.
- To be renewed in our minds.
- To live the *spiritual life* by *putting off* the old man and *putting on* the new, spiritual man.

Our outline for change is called the “Ten Attitudes of Victorious Living.”

God promises His Word will not return to Him void, therefore, we strive to live and share Biblical principles with an attitude of *love, acceptance* and *forgiveness*.

◆ SUPPORT MEETINGS

“The Most Excellent Way” Fellowship/Support Meetings are held weekly, with God’s Word as our *sole* authority, Jesus Christ as our *only power*, and His Holy Spirit as our *guide*.

Many participants have attended A.A. and Al-Anon meetings, and come to “The Most Excellent Way” seeking an environment in which to freely express their faith in Jesus. Others are backslidden Christians, timid and shame-faced, who God draws back into fellowship with Him. Unbelievers come and find genuine love, peer support, Christ and *eternal* hope.

◆ FAMILY SUPPORT MEETINGS . . .

. . . help spouses, parents and “adult children” to stop trying to control, fix and blame their dependent loved ones for their own misery. They receive loving support and learn how others are becoming GOD-dependent: the process of taking personal responsibility for their thoughts, attitudes and actions in order to change their turbulent lifestyles.

◆ THE CHILDREN’S MEETING . . .

. . . is a unique environment — an alternative to child-care — in which youngsters freely express their feelings of fear, hopelessness, guilt and frustration typically felt by children living with chemically dependent parents. *Our kids* are validated for who they are, and are assured that Jesus will never leave them nor forsake them.

◆ LOVE, ACCEPTANCE & FORGIVENESS

The quality of love we desire to share is God’s *agape*—the ability to accept and forgive one another just as God, the Father, accepts and forgives us because of our faith in Jesus, His Son.

“The Most Excellent Way” is to:

- Be reconciled to God through Jesus.
- Grow in faith and knowledge of Christ.
- Gain a better understanding of the sin nature that leads to addiction and obsessive, self-centered behavior.
- Learn and apply Biblical principles for living joy-filled, productive lives.
- Provide support to those who desire freedom from drug and alcohol dependency, and self-centered behavior.
- Pray for one another.
- Love one another.
